


Winter Storm Possible This Weekend

Winter Storm Possible This Weekend Key Points




Hazards, Timing and Duration: Snow spreads into northern Indiana Saturday evening and across the entire area Saturday night. Heaviest snowfall rates Saturday night into Sunday morning. Snow continues into Sunday night before diminishing. Gusty east winds will produce some blowing and drifting snow Saturday night into Sunday morning in Indiana.



Areas Impacted: Primary and secondary roads throughout the region will become snow covered and hazardous. Poor travel likely overnight Saturday and Sunday.




Confidence: Confidence is high that there will be snow associated with this system. Confidence is medium with respect to the exact track and amounts. Intense banded snowfall is possible Saturday night, but the exact location still remains uncertain. The snow may mix with sleet at times from Monticello to Portland, IN which would limit snowfall totals there.





Winter Weather Quick Facts and Preparedness:



Quick facts you should know about winter weather:

- As little as 1/16" of ice can begin to impact roadways and sidewalks.
- 70% of snow and ice related injuries occur in automobiles. Leave extra space between you and the vehicle in front of you. Take it slow on ice and snow.

Preparedness:

- A Winter Storm Watch is issued when conditions are favorable for significant winter weather. Time to prepare!
- A **Winter Storm Warning** is issued when a combination of heavy snow, blowing snow, and possibly ice mixed with snow is expected to impact the area. *Time to act!*
- A Winter Weather Advisory is issued when conditions will cause travel difficulties and other minor impacts. Use caution.
