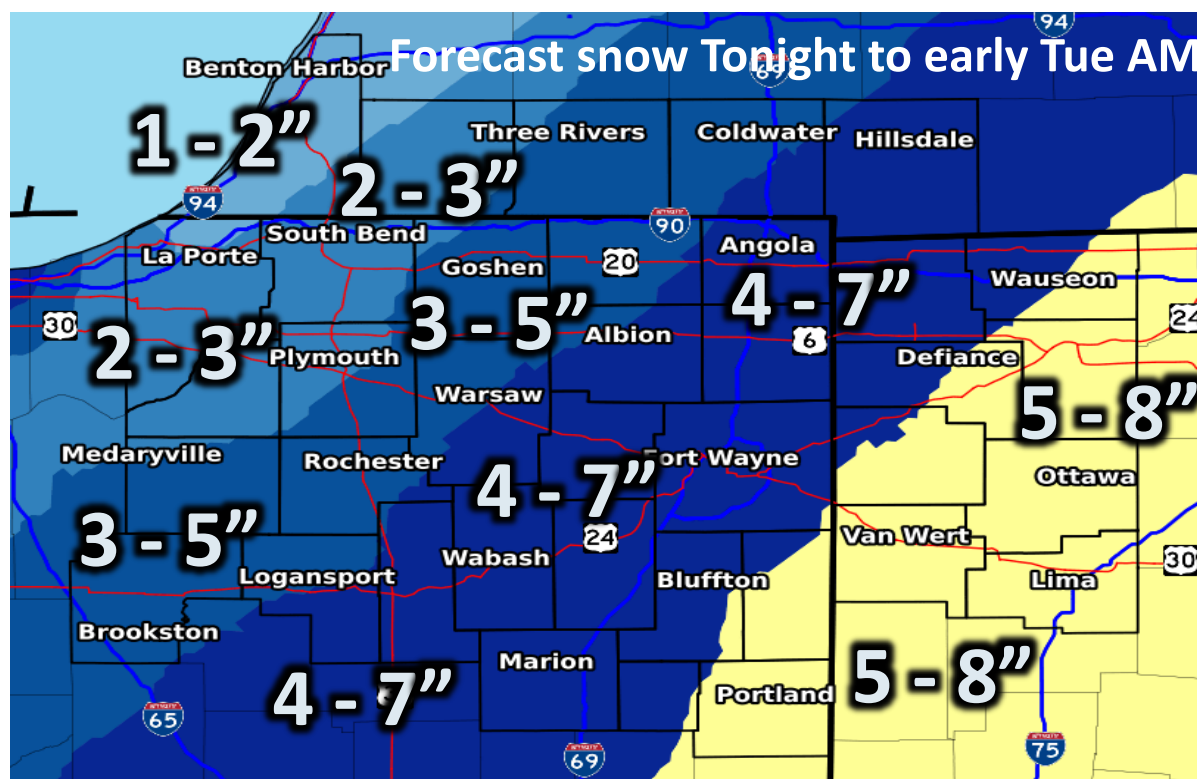

- Snow will move in late tonight and persist into late Monday night
- Graphic above shows forecast total accumulations through early Tuesday
- Monday AM/PM commutes and Tue AM commute likely to be impacted in many areas
- Wind chills of 0 to 20 below early this morning and to 10 below Mon AM

Slight increase to forecast snowfall amounts.

Winter Weather Advisory has been expanded slightly to the west.

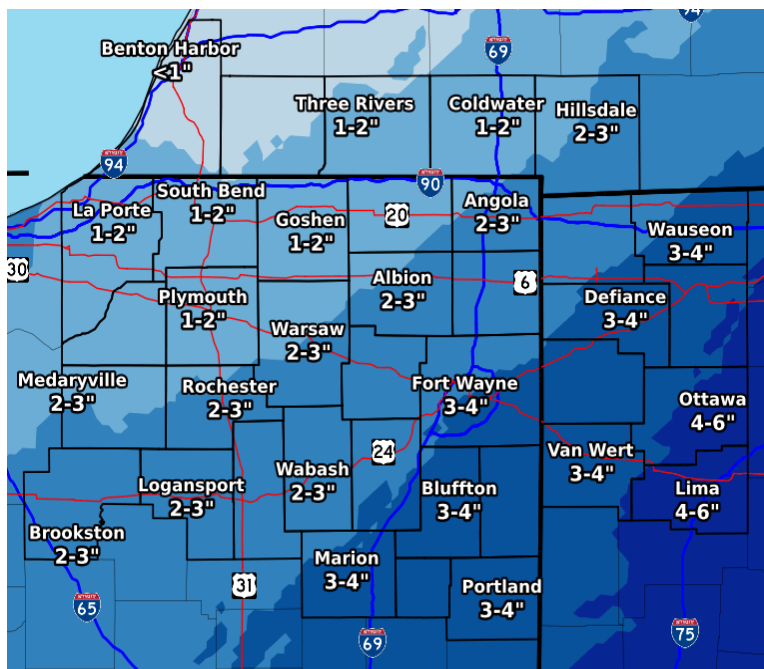
Start time of winter weather advisory moved a few hours earlier tonight.

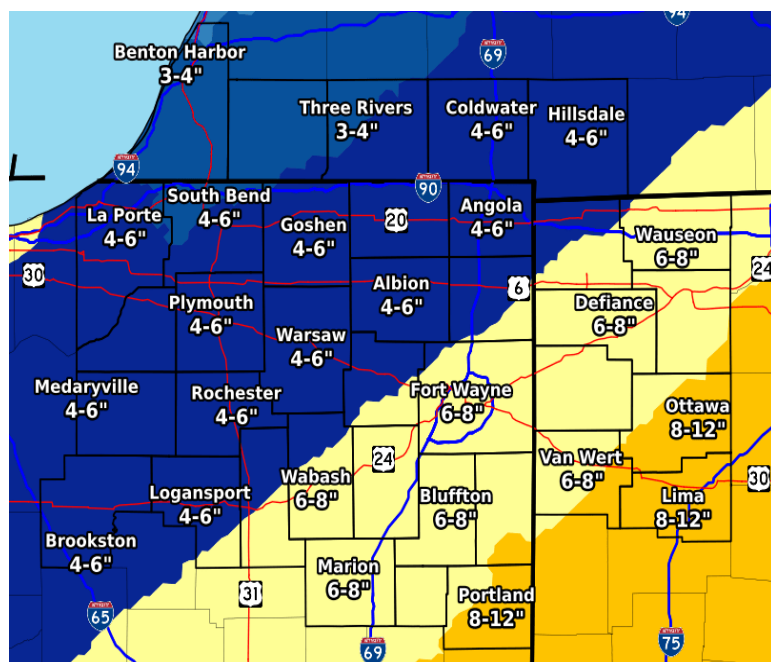

### Possible Snowfall Ranges

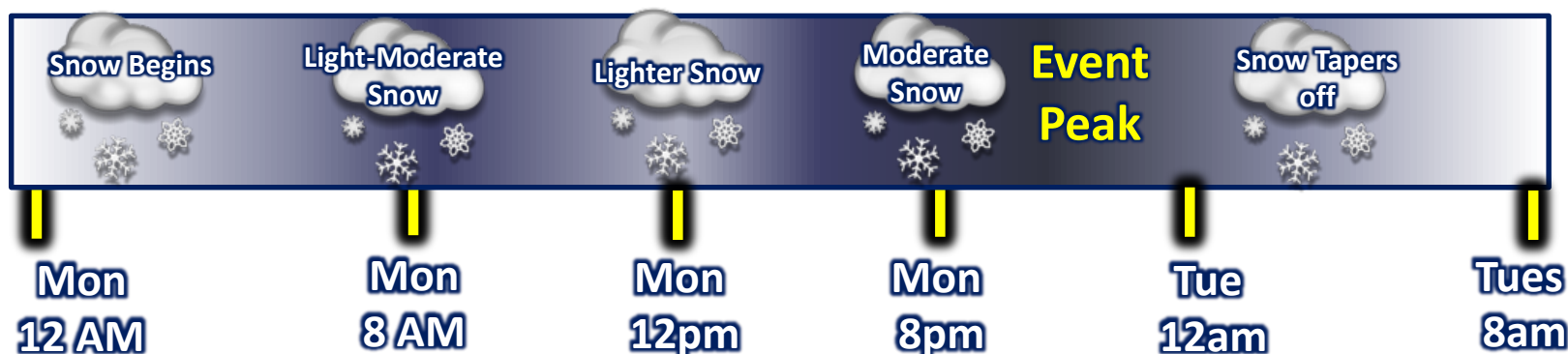
#### Expect at Least This Much



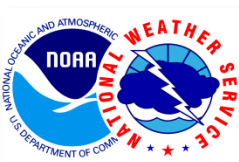
#### Potential for This Much



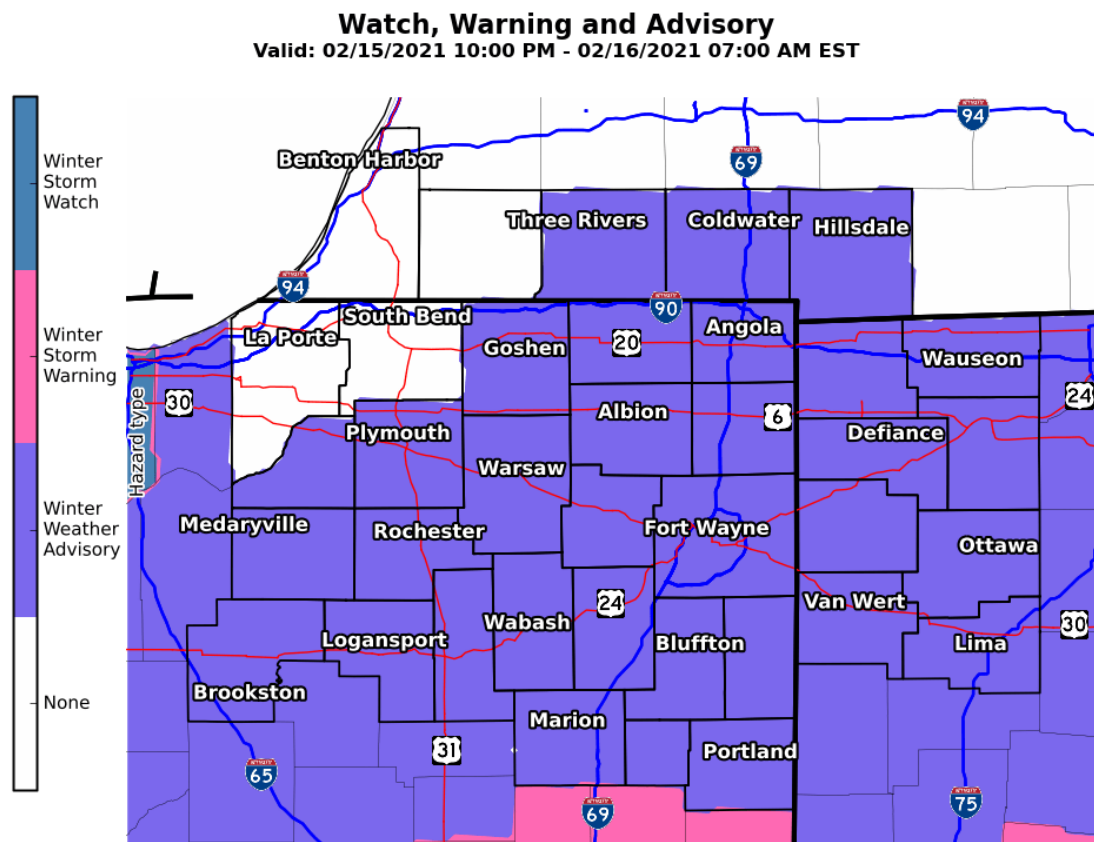
### Forecast Timeline



- Any change in the track of the system could cause a shift in the highest accumulations
- The maps show the minimum expected amounts as well as potential worst case scenario

## Watches, Warnings & Advisories



### Winter Weather Quick Facts and Preparedness:



#### *Quick facts you should know about winter weather:*

- As little as 1/16" of ice can begin to impact roadways and sidewalks.
- 70% of snow and ice related injuries occur in automobiles. Leave extra space between you and the vehicle in front of you. Take it slow on ice and snow.

#### *Preparedness:*

- A **Winter Storm Watch** is issued when conditions are favorable for significant winter weather. *Time to prepare!*
- A **Winter Storm Warning** is issued when a combination of heavy snow, blowing snow, and possibly ice mixed with snow is expected to impact the area. *Time to act!*
- A **Winter Weather Advisory** is issued when conditions will cause travel difficulties and other minor impacts. Use caution.
