Key Messages


- → Risk of severe thunderstorms this evening/tonight and again Tuesday.


Overview This Evening/Tonight


What: Potential strong to severe thunderstorms this evening into tonight. Main threats: damaging wind gusts in excess of 60 mph and isolated large hail. Isolated tornado cannot be ruled out in the Slight Risk area. Localized heavy rain/flooding possible.

Where: Southern Lower Michigan, NW Indiana

When: Evening/Early Tonight, 6pm-11pm EDT

Confidence: Medium

Overview Tuesday/Tuesday Evening


What: Potential scattered severe thunderstorms late Tuesday afternoon and evening. Primary threat is damaging wind gusts in excess of 60 mph. isolated large hail and heavy rainfall are also possible.


Where: Northern Indiana, Southern Lower Michigan,

Northwest Ohio

When: Tuesday evening/night, especially 8 PM-Midnight

Confidence: Low

Dangerous Heat and Humidity Likely for Tuesday Through Thursday

What

→ High temperatures around 90 Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday with peak afternoon heat indices in the upper 90s to 105 degrees each day

Where


→ Southern Lower Michigan, Northern Indiana, Northwest Ohio

When

→ Afternoon and early evening on Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday

Confidence

→ MEDIUM to HIGH. Day to day details will depend on cloud/storm coverage
