Snow and freezing rain underway, spreading east this evening

Key Messages

- Snow, accumulating 3 to 6 inches with lesser amounts south and east due to ice
- Ice accretion of 0.10" to 0.20", primarily over northwest Ohio and east-central Indiana
- Narrow corridor of 0.25" ice
- A Winter Weather Advisory in effect through 7am EST Thursday

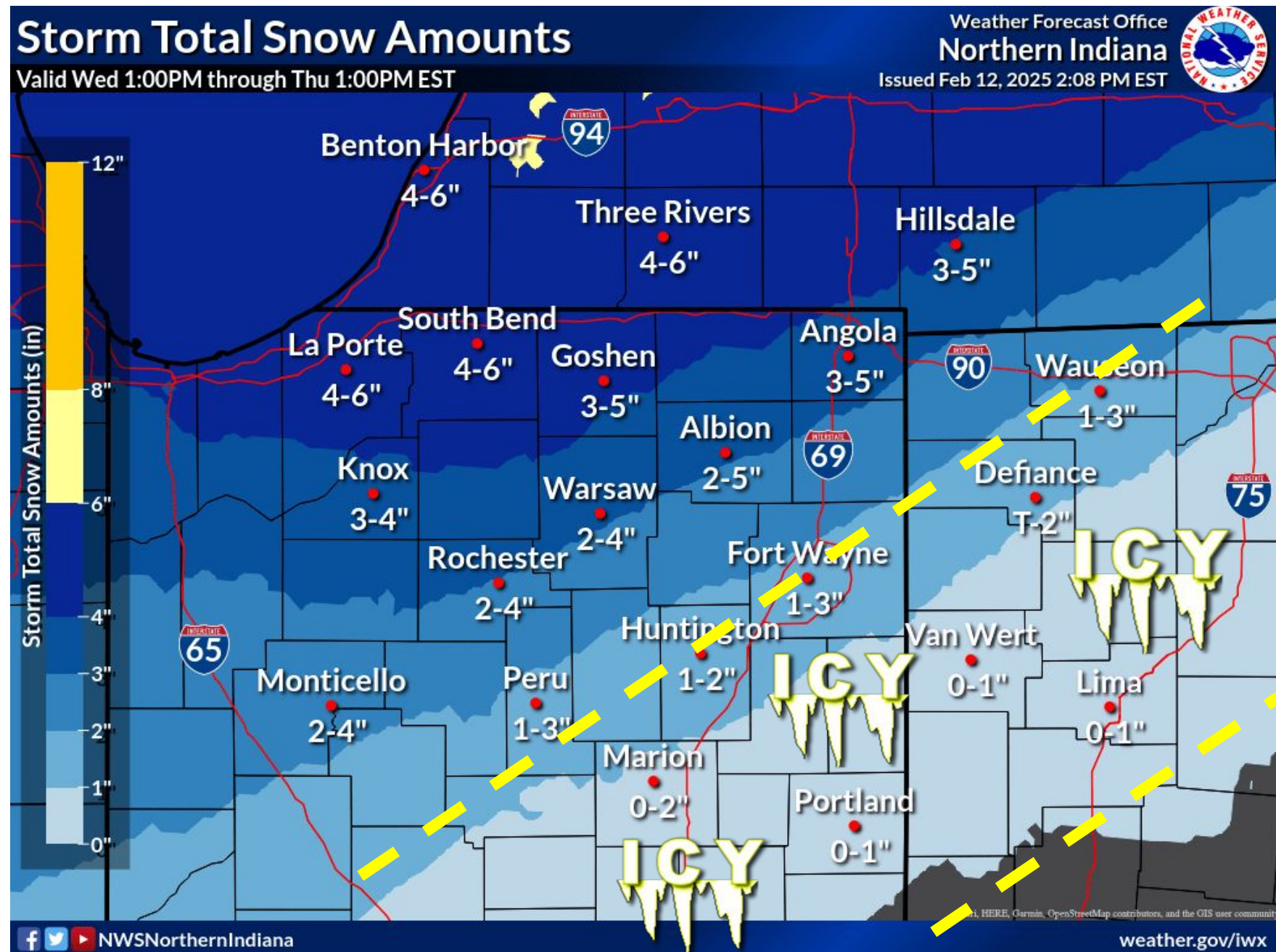

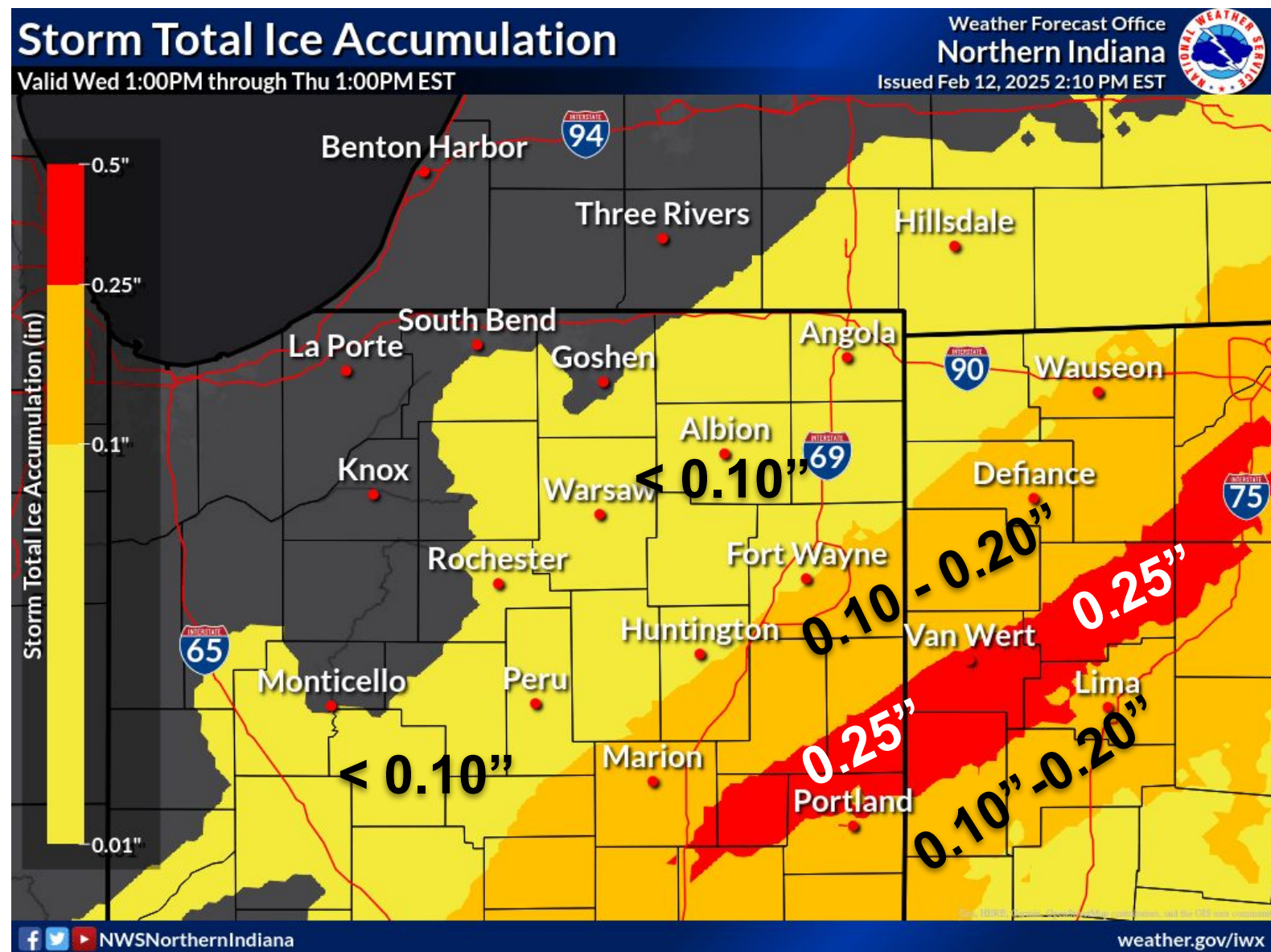


Ice Accumulation Forecast

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Overview

- Freezing rain will be the dominant precipitation type from northwest Ohio through east-central Indiana
- Ice accretion of 0.10" to 0.20" is expected as shown (high confidence)
- A narrow area of ice accretion of 0.25" or more is possible (low to medium confidence)
- Untreated surfaces will be slippery this evening through the Thursday morning commute
- West wind gusts Thursday morning near 20 mph could down branches and powerlines





Precipitation Types

Overview

- Widespread wintry weather including snow, freezing rain, and even sleet, is expected this evening.
- Precipitation tapers off from west to east between midnight and 6AM EST
- Lake effect snow showers develop by daybreak and persist into Thursday afternoon (blue box at right)
- Lake effect snow brings about 1” of additional accumulation for lake-adjacent counties

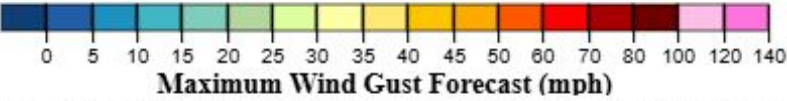
Wind Gust Forecast (mph)

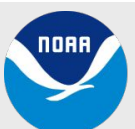
