Winter Weather Advisory in Effect

Key Messages

- Multi-faceted winter weather ahead:
 - ◆ Saturday AM: Any lingering snow changes to freezing rain and then eventually just rain/drizzle. A glaze to 0.05" of ice is possible
- Another round of snow is likely tonight into Sunday AM with 1-4" of snow.
- Northwest wind gusts up to 35-40 mph on Sunday. Blowing snow will be possible and will lower visibilities on Sunday afternoon and evening. N-S oriented roads will be the most impacted by blowing snow.

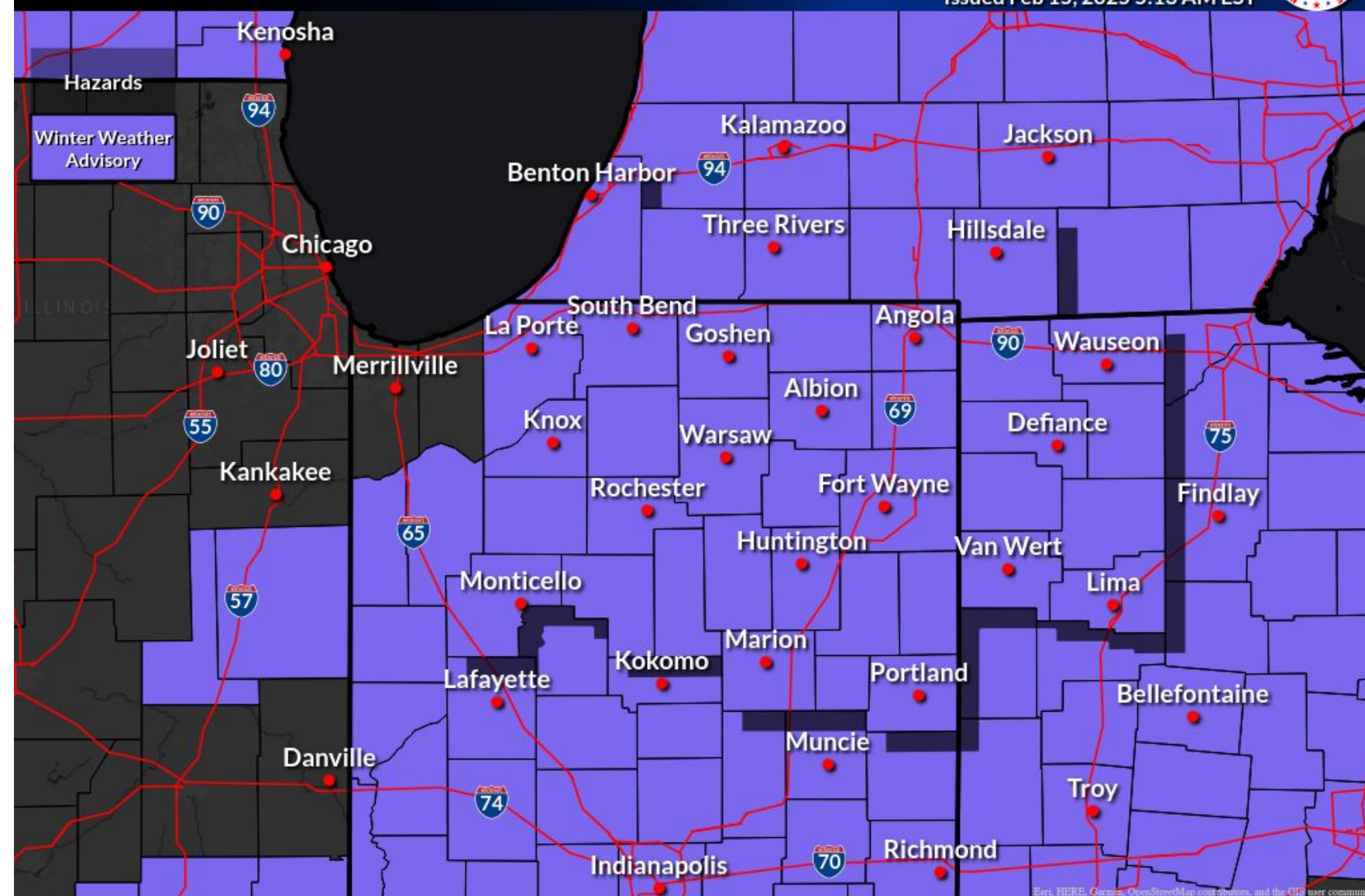

Timing & Threats

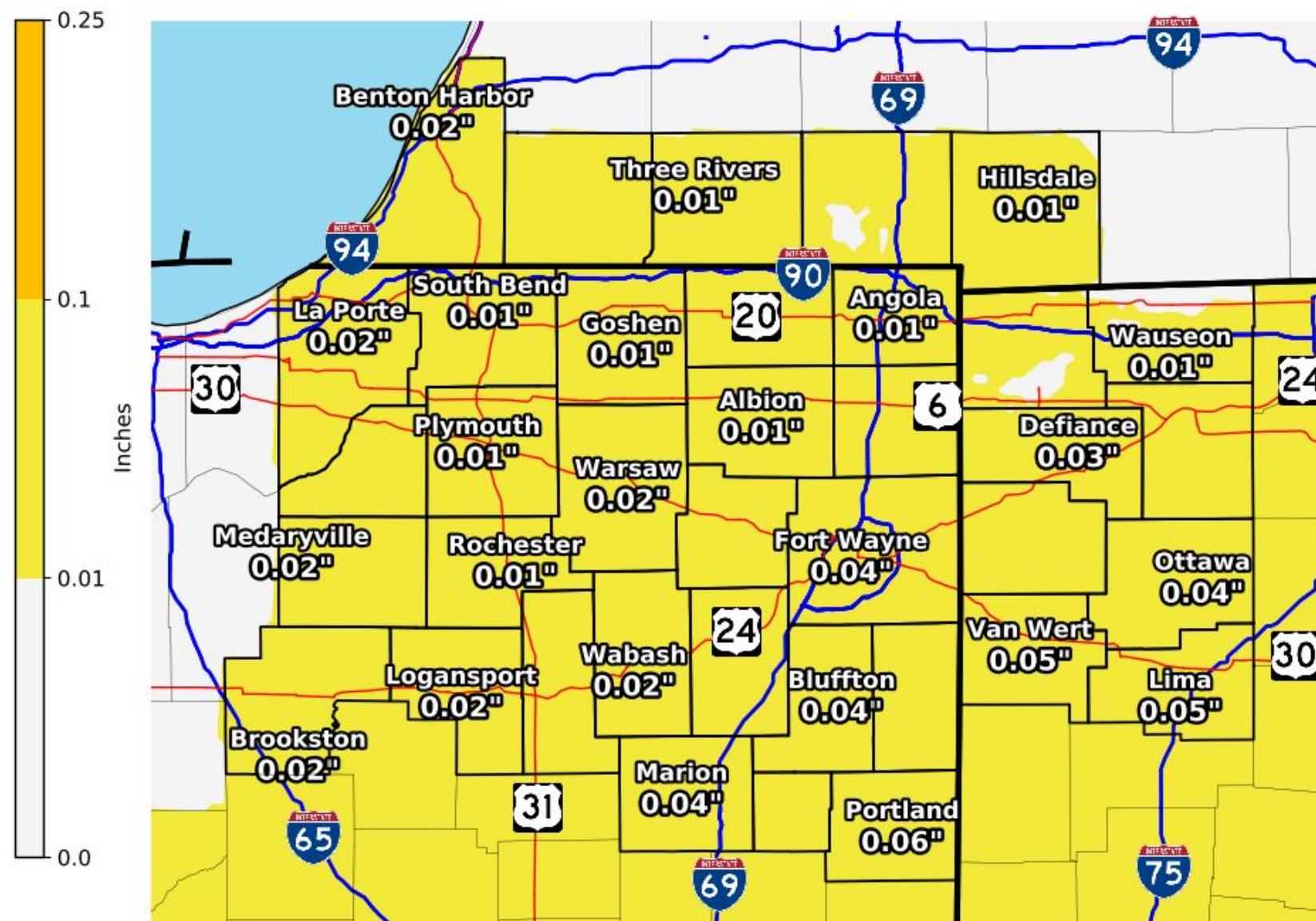


Timing

- Snow changes to freezing rain beginning around daybreak this morning, from south to north
- A glaze to 0.05" of ice is expected
- Freezing rain then eventually changes to mostly rain/drizzle from south to north through this morning as temperatures rise above freezing

Freezing Rain/Snowfall Forecast



Timing/Details

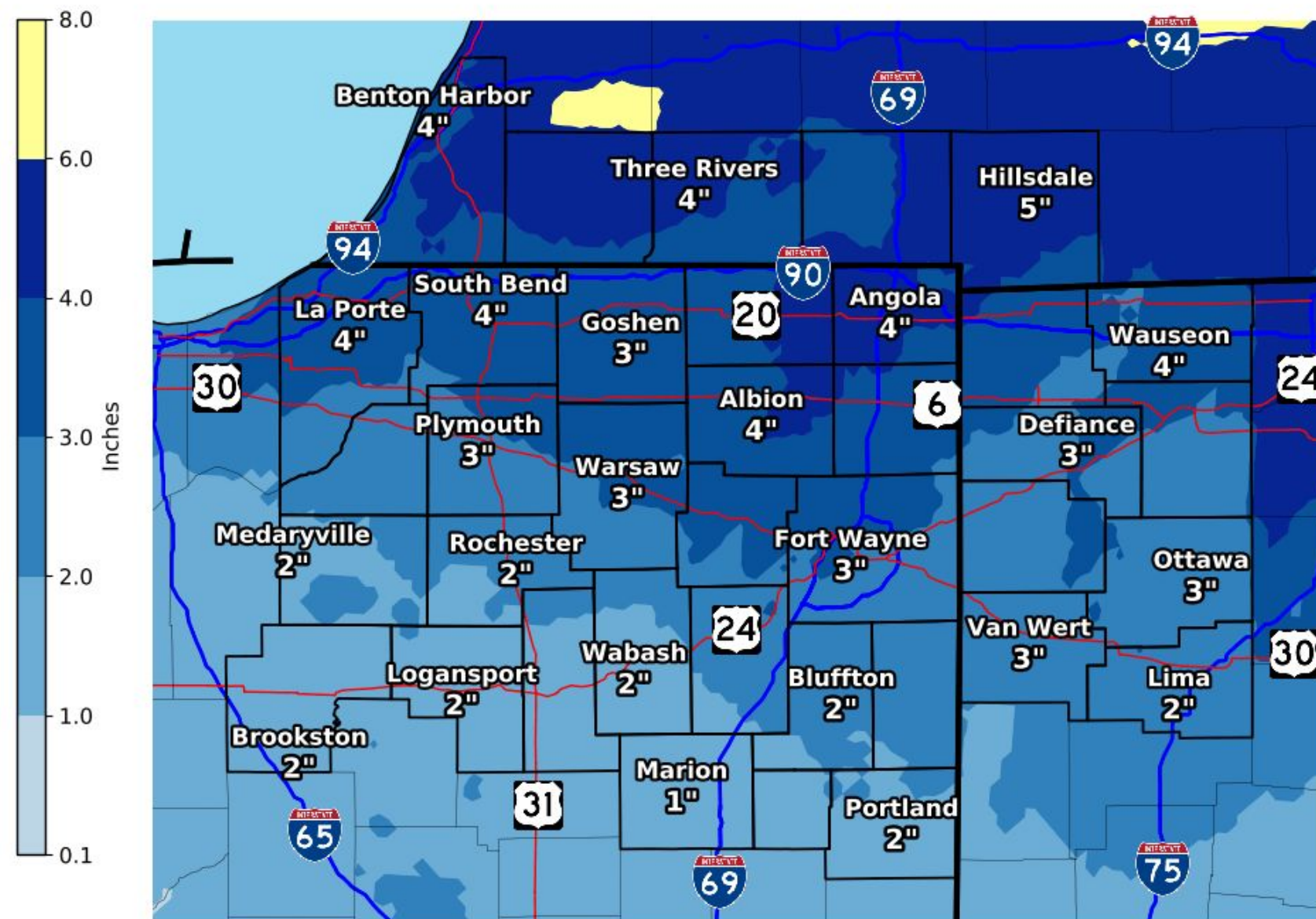
- Moving from north to south, freezing rain returns over southern MI counties and moves southward through northern IN around 5-6 PM EST
- Additional ice amounts less than 0.10"
- Freezing rain then switches over to all snowfall from northwest to southeast after 7-9 PM EST
- An additional 1 to 4 inches of snowfall Saturday night into Sunday
- Northwest wind gusts up to 35-40 mph. Blowing snow will be possible and will lower visibilities on Sunday afternoon and evening.



Areas of slippery travel due to ice and snow. N-S oriented roads will be the most impacted by blowing snow

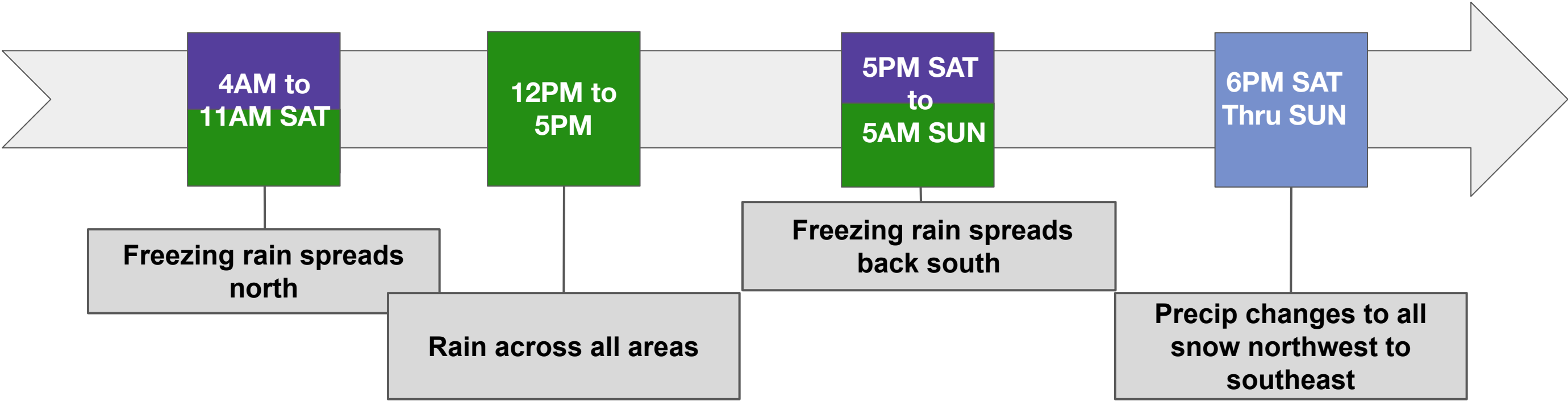




Precipitation Type Timeline

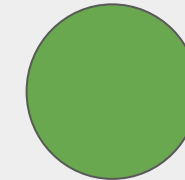

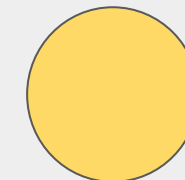
Winter Weather Impact Timeline

For southwest Lower Michigan, northern Indiana, and northwest Ohio

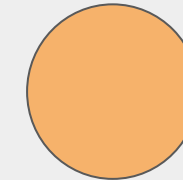
