



Severe Weather Chances on Saturday

March 14, 2025

Two rounds of severe storms possible: before daybreak Saturday and again Saturday PM

Key Messages

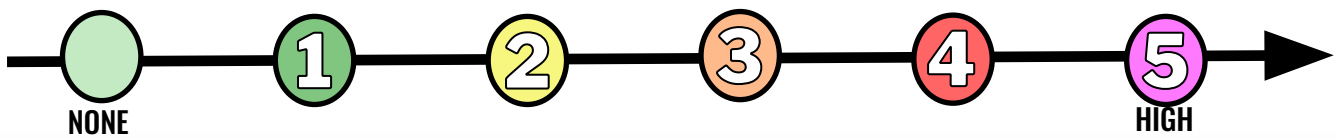
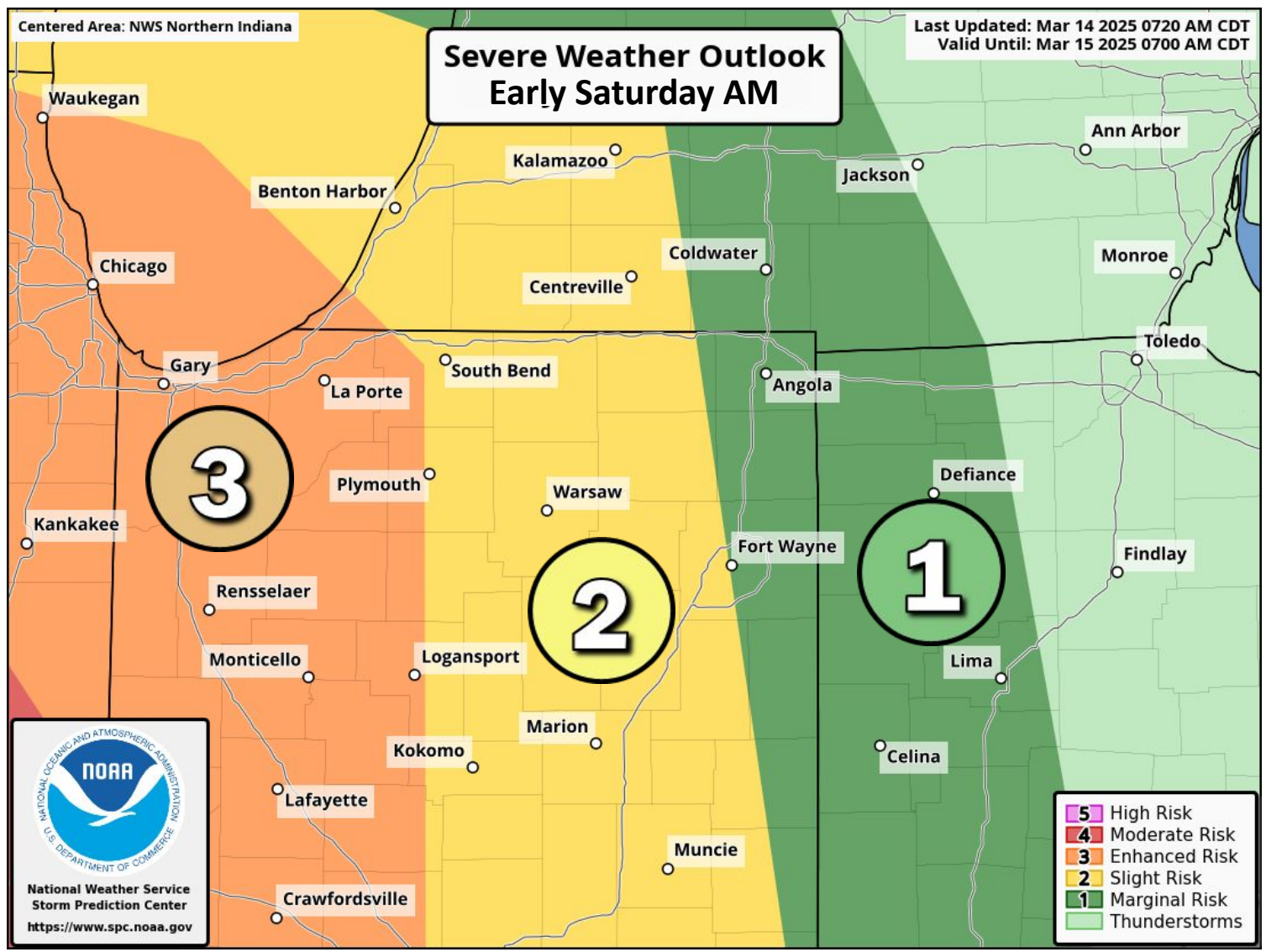
- **Tonight**
 - ◆ A weakening line of showers and thunderstorms moves through early Saturday morning with a risk for severe thunderstorms, mainly west of I-69 between 1am-5am EDT. Damaging winds in excess of 60 mph remain the primary threat
- **Saturday:**
 - ◆ Strong southerly winds expected to gust 45 to 55 mph early Saturday afternoon (isolated 55-60 mph)
 - ◆ Isolated, marginally severe, storms possible 5pm-10pm Saturday afternoon-evening, best chances along and east of I-69. Damaging winds the primary threat

NEW Important Updates

- Saturday (Day 2) SPC Marginal Severe Risk has been expanded west to include most of the forecast area

Next Scheduled Briefing

- None, unless a forecast change warrants it





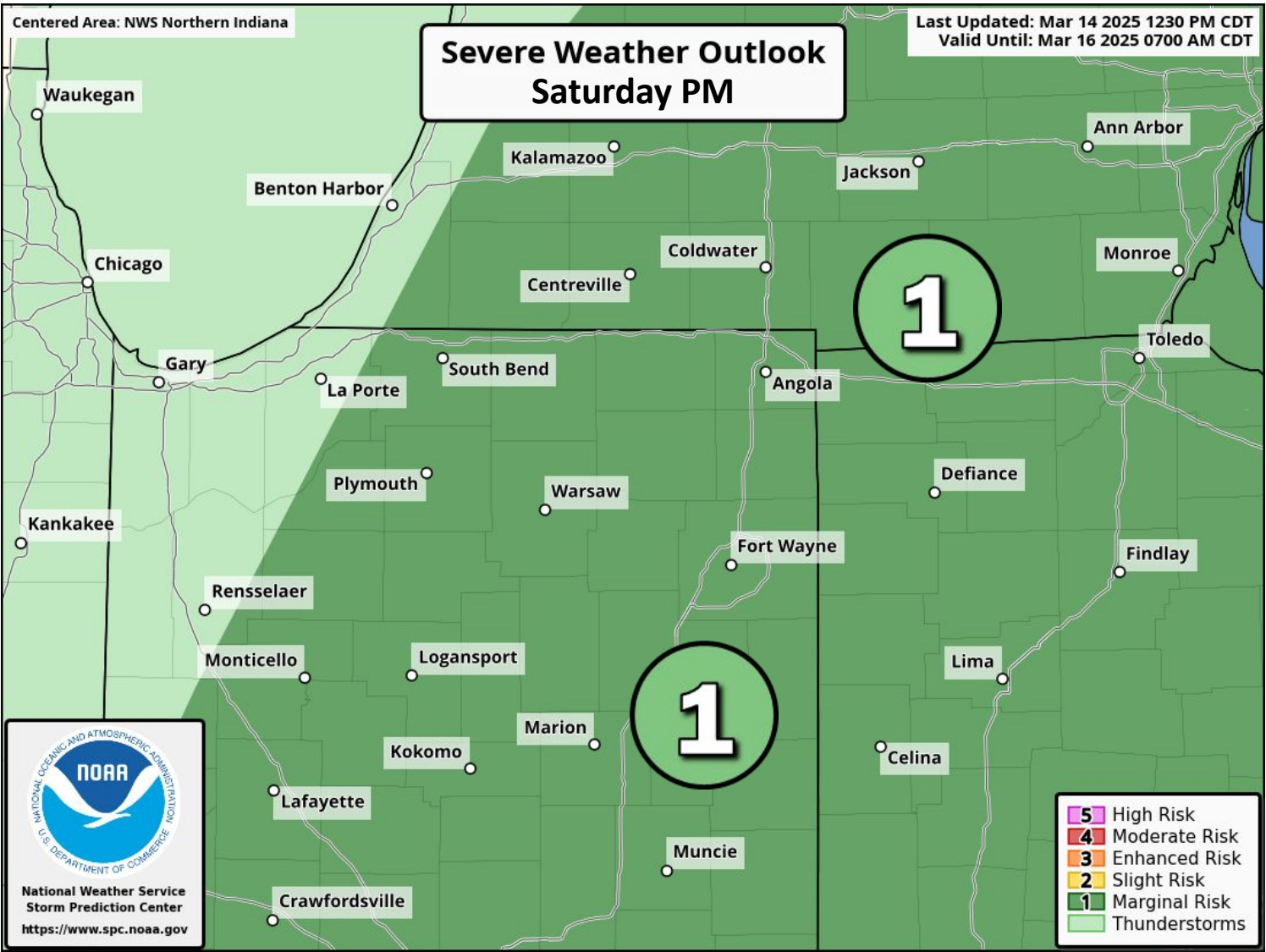
Severe Thunderstorm Potential Sat PM

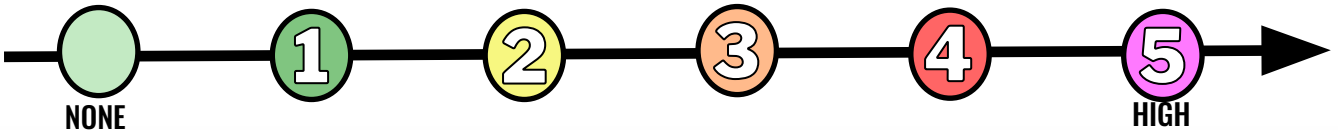
Marginal (1) Severe Risk 5-10 pm EDT Saturday

Key Messages

- **What:** Marginal Risk for isolated severe storms
- **Timing/Location:** Best chances 5-10 PM EDT, mainly along and east of I-69
- **Primary Hazards:** Damaging wind gusts in excess of 60 mph is the primary risk, though an isolated tornado cannot be ruled out
- **Confidence:** Low; Clouds and later timing of another system arriving from the south could limit instability and thunderstorm development



SEVERE THUNDERSTORM RISK





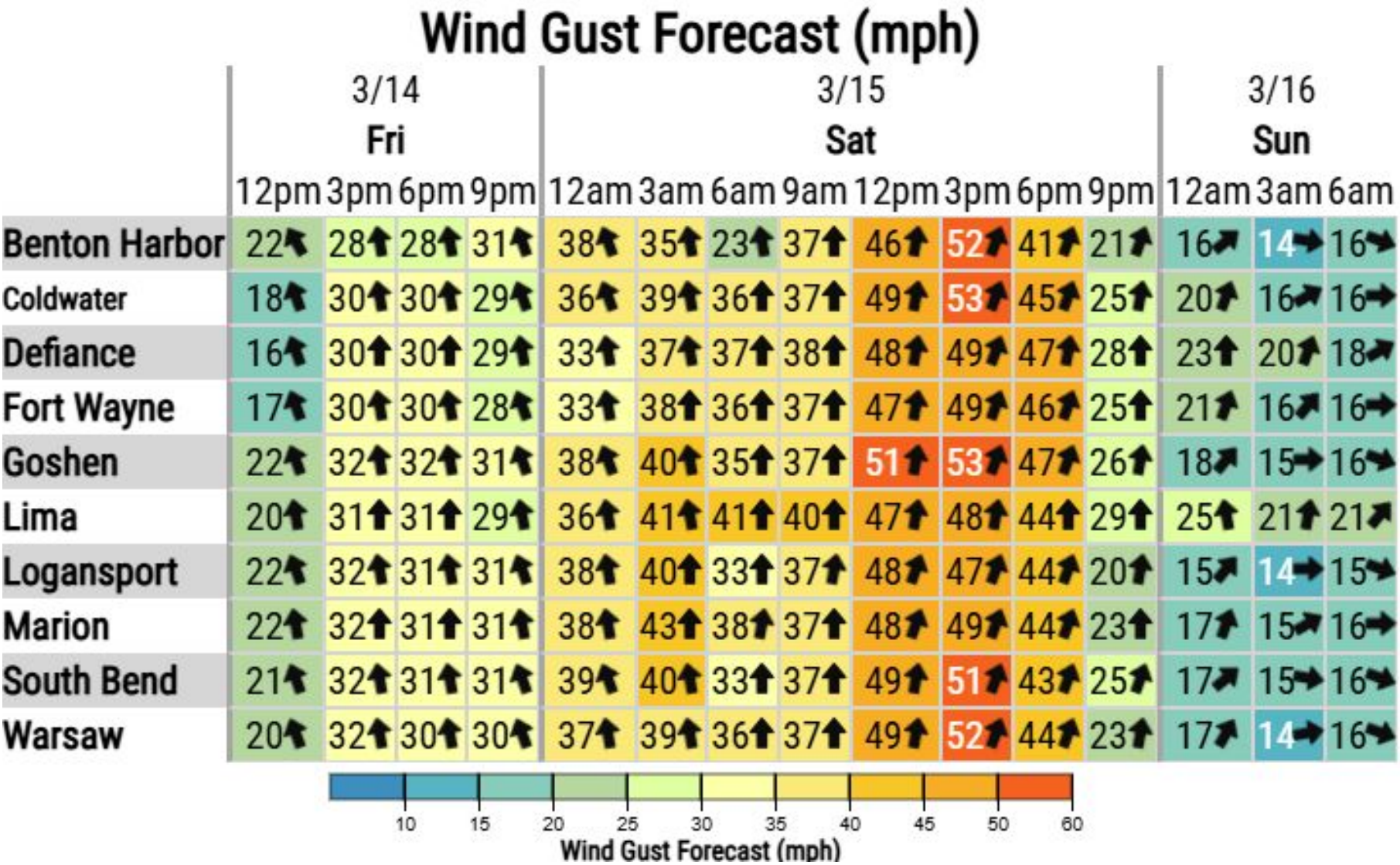
Strong Winds on Saturday

Wind gusts 45+ mph will cause some potential for Elevated Fire Danger

Key Messages

- Southerly winds are expected to gust between 45 and 55 mph at times Saturday afternoon. A few gust may reach 55-60 mph.
- High profile vehicles could be impacted (especially on E-W oriented roads) by the stronger winds
- Minor tree damage possible with any 45+ mph gusts
- Above normal temperatures combined with strong winds will also increase concerns for any outdoor burns to quickly lose containment, possibly impacting structures or causing smoke plumes over roadways. **Do not burn on Saturday!**



ENHANCED RISK

Numerous severe storms possible.

Some longer lived severe storms -- a few intense storms possible.

Have multiple ways to get NWS warnings and seek shelter immediately when warnings are issued for your location.

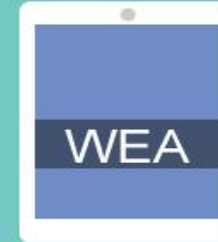
