Damaging winds will be the main threat this afternoon and evening

Key Messages

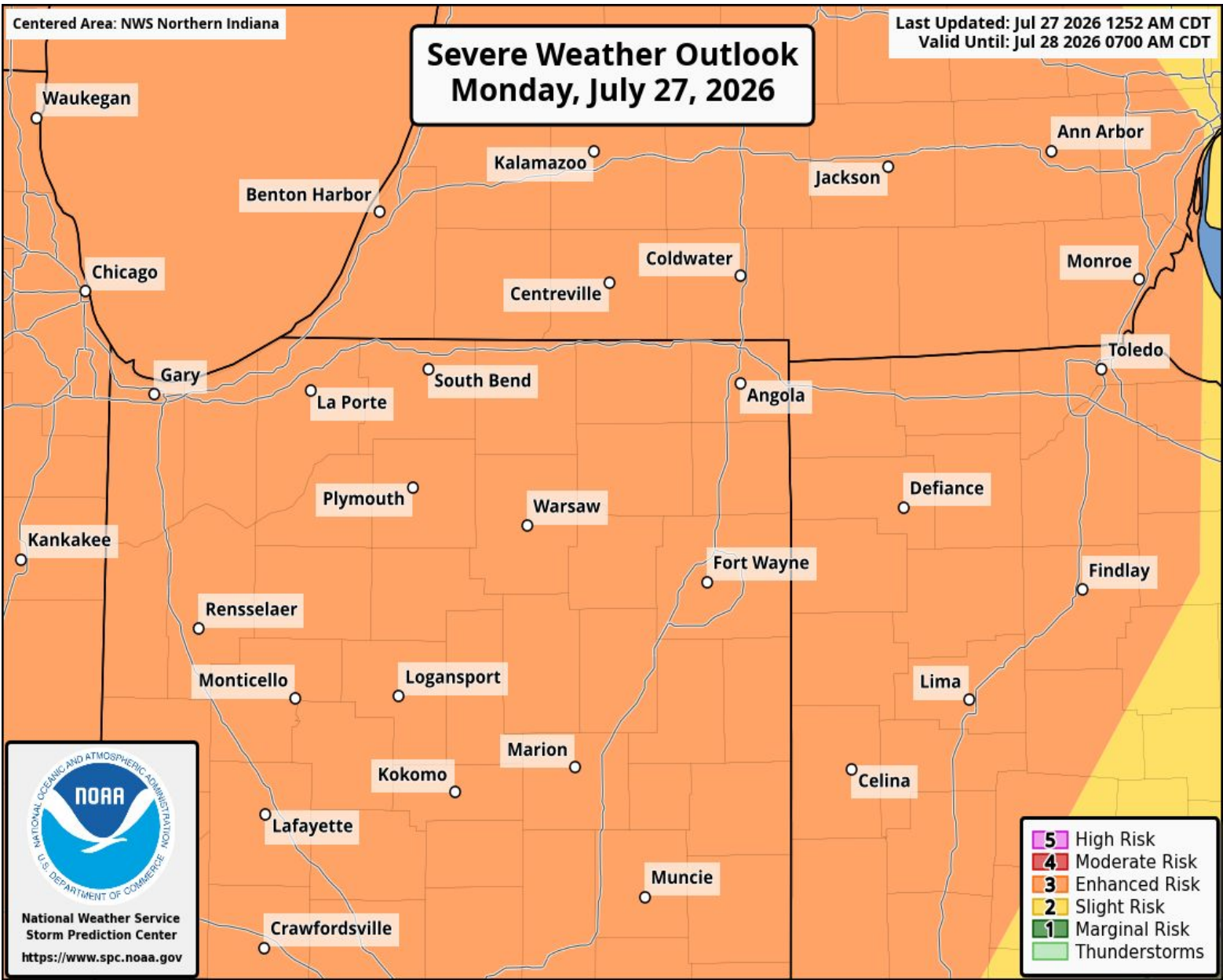
- There is an **Enhanced Risk** for severe weather (level 3 of 5) today with strong to severe storms likely.
- **A line of strong to severe thunderstorms is expected to move from north to south across our forecast area today.**
 - ◆ Timing: 2 to 8 PM EDT
 - ◆ Threats: Damaging winds likely and isolated tornadoes possible
 - ◆ Confidence: Medium

NEW Important Updates

- Our entire forecast area has been upgraded into an Enhanced Risk for severe weather
- Updated timing for storms
- Increased probabilities for damaging winds

Next Scheduled Briefing

- This will be the last briefing unless the forecast significantly changes

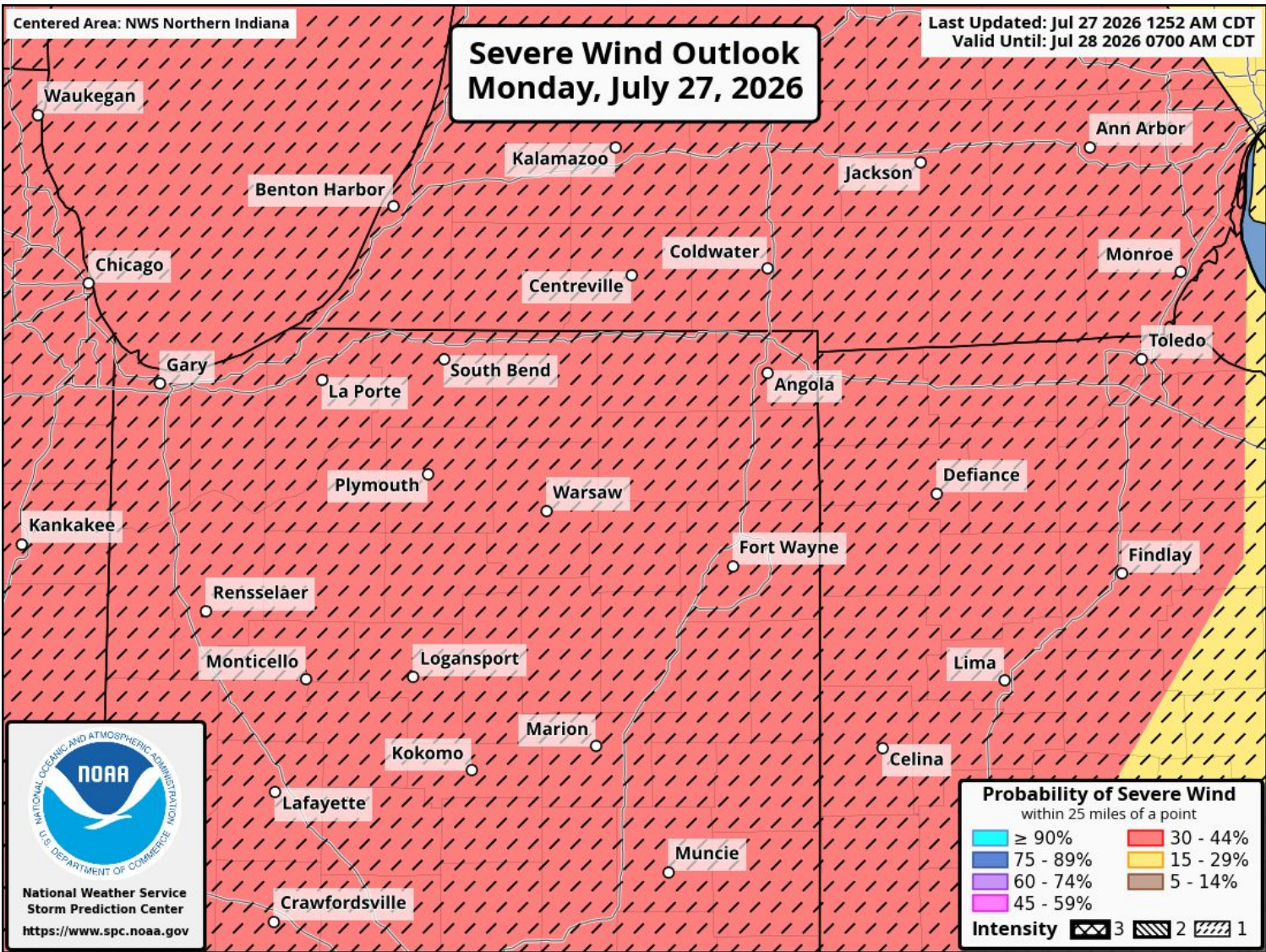
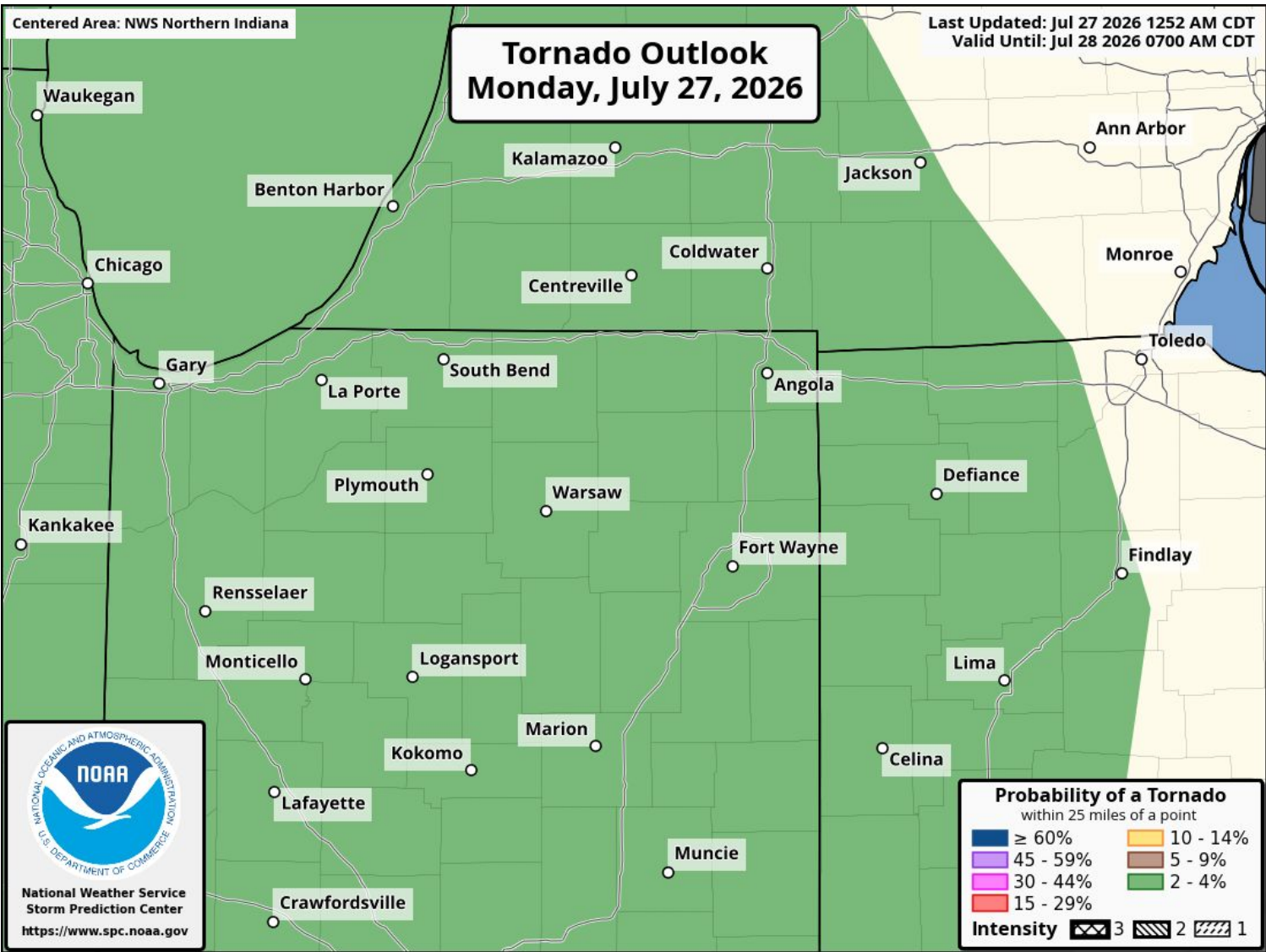

Severe Weather Threats Today

Damaging winds likely and an isolated tornado or two possible this afternoon and evening



Damaging wind gusts of 60-70 mph will be the main threat today with a line of strong to severe storms that moves through this afternoon and evening. Scattered significant gusts 75+ mph possible. An isolated embedded tornado or two is also possible.





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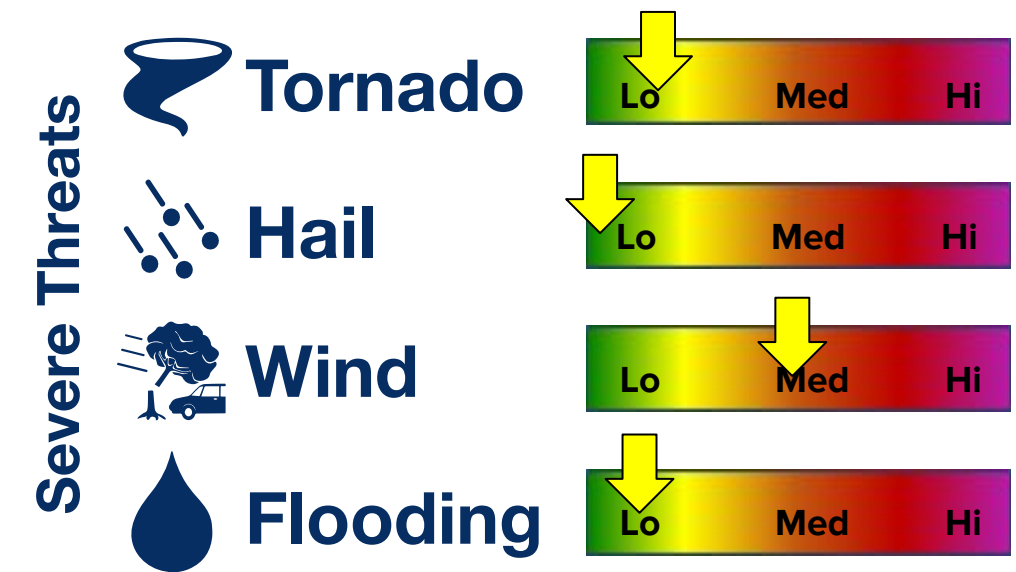
Threats and Confidence Levels

Overview

Damaging winds are likely today, including potential for scattered significant gusts of 75 mph or higher. An isolated tornado or two is also possible.

Actions

 Be weather aware and ready to act.
Have multiple ways to receive warning information!



Severe Weather



Damaging winds 60 to 70 mph likely with gusts over 75 mph possible. An isolated tornado or two also possible.

Location



Our entire forecast area may be impacted by a line of strong to severe storms this afternoon into early evening. Some uncertainty remains on the exact track of storms.

Timing



Best chances from 2 to 8 PM EDT today. Additional scattered storms possible this evening after 8 PM EDT but the severe threat will be much lower then.

STORM PLANNING TIMELINE

A few days out

If the forecast calls for severe weather in a few days, start preparing now.



Make sure that you have emergency supplies



Know your safe places



Have a family communication plan

The day before

The day before, forecast accuracy continues to improve.



Adjust plans



Make sure your phone can receive WEAs



Ensure your shelter is clean and accessible

The day of

Remain vigilant and aware of any active Watches. A Warning may be issued at a moment's notice!



Remind your family of the communication plan



Know how to evacuate and/or get to safety from wherever you are



When a Warning is issued, you may only have seconds to take action!
