More storms capable of heavy rain and damaging winds possible today

Key Messages

- **Flood Watch has been extended for areas along/south of US-30 today**
 - ◆ **Timing:** Several rounds of storms through late afternoon. Rainfall rates 1-2+” per hour.
 - ◆ **Confidence:** Medium
- **Marginal/Slight Risk for Severe Storms Today, mainly south of US-30**
 - ◆ **Timing:** Best chances **11 am-5 pm EDT**
 - ◆ **Confidence:** Low
 - ◆ **Threats:**
 - Heavy rain and flooding
 - Damaging Wind

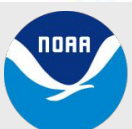
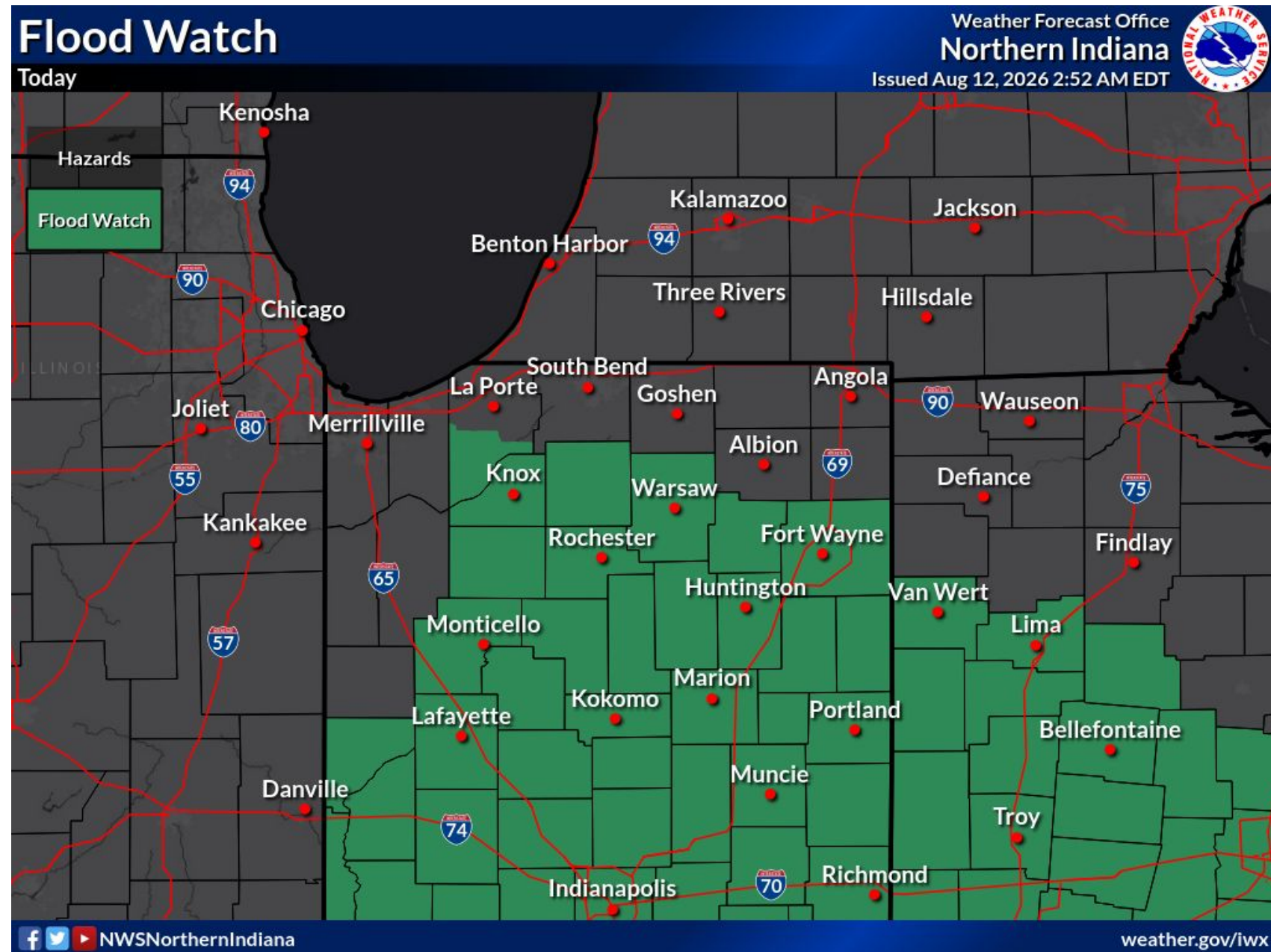

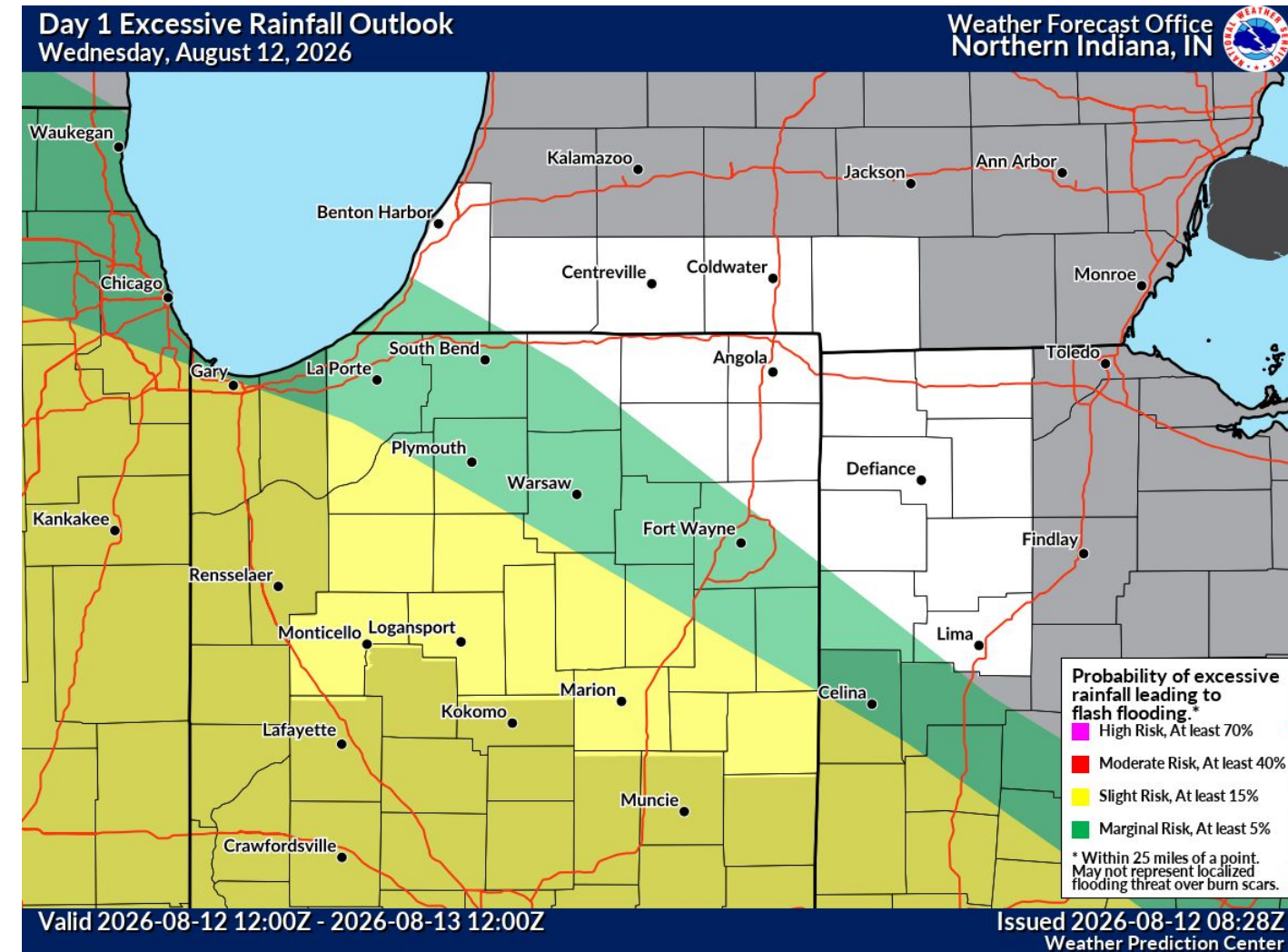
Flood Potential

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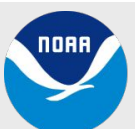
More heavy rain possible in the same area hit yesterday

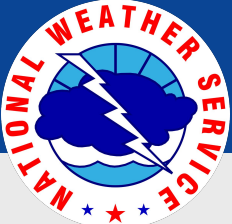


24 hour rainfall totals
